Western Cooperative Fertilizers Limited (WESTCO) Opportunity to be heard on the Designated Officer Order Issued to WESTCO

On November 19, 2007, a Designated Officer of the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission¹ (CNSC), pursuant to paragraph 37(2) (f) of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act*² (NSCA), issued an order to WESTCO. The order required WESTCO to take specific actions and measures to protect the environment and the health and safety of persons. Pursuant to subsection 37(6) of the NSCA, the Designated Officer referred the order to the Commission for review to confirm, amend, replace or revoke the order. The Commission amended the Designated Officer order on April 21, 2008 and issued Reasons for Decision on June 9, 2008.
