ERRATUM

Atomic Energy of Canada Limited Application to Renew the Nuclear Research and Test Establishment Decommissioning Licence for the Whiteshell Laboratories

Following a hearing on November 5, 2008, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC), pursuant to section 24 of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act*¹, renewed the Nuclear Research and Test Establishment Decommissioning Licence issued to Atomic Energy of Canada Limited for its Whiteshell Laboratories. The licence, NRTEDL-08.00/2018, is valid from January 1, 2009 to December 31, 2018.

The following correction is made to the English version of the *Record of Proceedings* document issued December 16, 2008 by the CNSC, pertaining to the Application to Renew the Nuclear Research and Test Establishment Decommissioning Licence for the Whiteshell Laboratories.

On page 1, paragraph 2, the last sentence, which reads as follows:

“The facility operated for approximately 40 years as a nuclear **operating** and test establishment and AECL applied for a licence to decommission the facility in 2002.”

is changed to

“The facility operated for approximately 40 years as a nuclear **research** and test establishment and AECL applied for a licence to decommission the facility in 2002.”
