The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in March 2010 to consider Atomic Energy of Canada Limited's (AECL) application to amend the Chalk River Laboratories (CRL) operating licence. CRL are located in Chalk River, Ontario.

AECL requested an amendment to the (CRL) operating licence to provide greater clarity and necessary updates to several licence conditions, and to include requirements for retention of an authorized inspection agency to provide pressure boundary services at CRL. These changes are considered administrative in nature and would not change the existing physical works or the physical activities at the licensed facility.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider the modifications requested by AECL.

Following the deliberations, the Commission's decision on this matter will be made available to the public on the CNSC Web site.

The Commission will consider written submissions from CNSC staff and AECL.
