The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in March 2010 to consider Atomic Energy of Canada Limited's (AECL) application to amend its Non-Power Reactor Operating Licence (NPROL) for the MAPLE 1 and MAPLE 2 reactors, and for the New Processing Facility, all located in Chalk River, Ontario.

AECL requested an amendment to its NPROL to maintain these installations in a non-operational Extended Shutdown State. AECL has completed the activities required to place these facilities into the Extended Shutdown State as permitted by the current operating licence.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider the modification requested by AECL.

Following the deliberations, the Commission's decision on this matter will be made available to the public on the CNSC Web site.

The Commission will consider written submissions from CNSC staff and AECL.
