The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in April 2010 to consider Atomic Energy of Canada Limited's (AECL) application to amend the Whiteshell Laboratories Decommissioning Licence (NRTEDL). The facility is located northeast of Winnipeg, Manitoba.

AECL requested that the submission dates for three reports be changed, and that two appendices be updated in the licence. These changes are considered administrative in nature and would not change the existing physical works or the physical activities at the licensed facility.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider the modification requested by AECL.

Following the deliberations, the Commission's decision on this matter will be made available to the public on the CNSC Web site.

The Commission will consider written submissions from CNSC staff and AECL.
