



Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in April 2010 to consider Cameco Corporation (Cameco)'s application regarding the McArthur River Operation uranium mine. The mine is located in Northern Saskatchewan

Cameco is seeking acceptance from the Commission of an amendment to its McArthur River's operating licence. The amendment request, if accepted, would allow Cameco an annual nominal production of 7 200 000 kilograms of uranium from McArthur while allowing the flexibility to produce up to a maximum of 900 000 kilograms more in a given year to make up for production shortfalls.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider Cameco's request in this case. There is no opportunity for the public to participate. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Cameco.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
