The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in September to consider Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG)'s request for a licence amendment for the Pickering B and Darlington Nuclear Generating Stations (NGS). The reactors are located respectively at Pickering and Darlington, Ontario.

OPG is seeking acceptance from the Commission for administrative changes for its Pickering B and Darlington NGS. The proposed changes include a revision to a licence condition to include an update to a Canadian Standards Association (CSA) standard and transitional provisions to achieve full compliance with another updated CSA standard.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider OPG's request in this case. There is no opportunity for the public to participate. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and OPG.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
