The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in September to consider the Environmental Assessment (EA) Screening Report relating to Denison Mines Incorporated (Denison)'s request to perform work at the decommissioned Stanrock mine. The Stanrock mine is located near Elliot Lake, Ontario.

CNSC staff request the Commission to approve the EASR for the proposed installation of two berms to stabilize and reinforce existing beaver dams.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider the EASR in this case. There is no opportunity for the public to participate. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Denison.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
