# *Revised Notice of Public Hearing*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces a change of date for Hearing Day Two on the application by GE-Hitachi Nuclear Energy Canada Inc. (GE-Hitachi) to renew its operating licence for two nuclear fuel fabrication facilities located in Toronto and Peterborough, Ontario. Hearing Day One took place on September 30, 2010. GE-Hitachi is requesting a combined licence for a term of ten-year for its two facilities.

Under the current licence for the Toronto facility, GE Hitachi is authorized to manufacture natural uranium dioxide pellets from natural uranium dioxide powder. The current licence for the Peterborough facility allows for the production and testing of fuel bundles from uranium dioxide pellets and zircaloy tubes.

**Hearing Day Two will take place on December 9, 2010 instead of December 8, 2010 as previously announced.**

The public hearing will be webcasted live via the CNSC Web site and archived for a period of 90 days. Public hearings follow the agenda published prior to the hearing date.

The public is invited to comment on GE-Hitachi's application for its licence renewal on Hearing Day Two. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by November 8, 2010 directly on-line at (<http://www.nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/commission/intervention/index.cfm>) or at the address below. The request must include the following information, as per the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation; and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.

Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. Please submit your personal information on a separate page if you wish to ensure its confidentiality. It should be noted that all submissions are available to the public upon request to the Secretariat.

GE-Hitachi's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations that were considered at Hearing Day One are not available on-line and must be requested through the Secretariat at the address below.
