The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in October to consider the approval of the Guidelines Scoping Document for AREVA Resources Canada Inc.'s (AREVA) proposed project for the receipt and processing of McArthur River Ore at the McClean Lake Operation located in northern Saskatchewan.

The proposed project is for the production of uranium ore concentrate at McClean Lake from McArthur River ore slurry over a three-year period. This project includes the transportation of ore from McArthur River to McClean Lake.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider the proposed Guidelines Scoping Document for AREVA's project. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and AREVA.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
