

Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in November to consider MDS Nordion, a Division of MDS (Canada) Inc.'s (MDS Nordion) application to amend the Nuclear Substance Processing Facility Operating Licence for its Kanata Operations Building located in Ottawa, Ontario.

MDS Nordion is seeking acceptance from the Commission to amend the current licence to reflect the company's name change from MDS Nordion, a Division of MDS (Canada) Inc. to Nordion (Canada) Inc. The amendment request for the name change is an administrative change; it is not the result of a corporate change.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider MDS Nordion's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and MDS Nordion.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
