## Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in December to consider Canadian Light Source Inc.'s (CLS) application to amend the Class IB Particle Accelerator Operating Licence for the CLS facility. The facility is located on the University of Saskatchewan campus, in Saskatoon.

CLS is seeking acceptance from the Commission to proceed with the construction of the Brockhouse Building Addition that will house the Brockhouse beamlines. The Commission is requested to amend Appendix A of CLS's licence to include the latest revision of the document entitled "CLSI Safety Report, Revision 11".

CLS is also seeking acceptance of a revised financial guarantee from the Commission. The financial guarantee requires a revision every five years.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider CLS's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and CLS.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
