The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in January 2011 to consider the Environmental Assessment Screening Report (EASR) relating to the proposal by Dalhousie University to decommission the Dalhousie University SLOWPOKE-2 Reactor (DUSR) Facility. The DUSR Facility is located in the Life Sciences Centre in the Department of Chemistry on the Dalhousie University campus in Halifax, Nova Scotia.

CNSC staff recommends the Commission to approve the EASR for the proposed decommissioning of the DUSR Facility.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider the EASR in this case. There is no opportunity for the public to participate. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Dalhousie University.
