The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in February to consider Ontario Power Generation Inc's (OPG) application to amend the Nuclear Power Reactor Operating licences for the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station B (PNGS-B) and the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station (DNGS). The reactors are respectively located in Pickering and Clarington, Ontario.

OPG is seeking acceptance from the Commission for the following administrative changes: updates to revisions of documents and a revision to a PNGS-B licence condition to reference a Canadian Standards Association (CSA) standard.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider OPG's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and OPG.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
