The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in March to consider an application by TRIUMF Accelerators Inc. to amend its operating licence for the TRIUMF particle accelerator facility, located in Vancouver, British Columbia.

TRIUMF Accelerators Inc. (TRIUMF) requested two amendments to the Licence. The first one is to temporarily relocate a section of the security fence on the west side of the TRIUMF site to facilitate the construction of a new stores building, as well as to update the site plan to properly illustrate this building. The second amendment, administrative in nature, has been requested in order to update the licence condition related to reporting requirements for fissile and fertile material.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider TRIUMF's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and TRIUMF.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
