The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in April to consider Atomic Energy of Canada Limited's (AECL) application to amend the Nuclear Research and Test Establishment Operating Licence for the Chalk River Laboratories (CRL) and the Non-Power Reactor Operating Licence for the Dedicated Isotope Facilities (DIF). The CRL and the DIF are both located in Chalk River, Ontario.

AECL is seeking acceptance from the Commission for the following administrative changes: replacement of a reference to an obsolete regulatory standard with the current standard reference, updates to revisions of documents, and revisions of CRL action levels.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider AECL's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and AECL.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
