## Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in April to consider the approval of the project-specific Guidelines Scoping Document for Cameco Corporation's (Cameco) proposed project for the establishment of a treatment plant and discharge system at its Rabbit Lake Operation.

The purpose of the proposed project is to establish a new reverse osmosis mine water treatment plant and discharge system at Cameco's Eagle Point mine in Rabbit Lake Operation. Cameco considers this system essential to permanently handle the predicted inflow volumes. The mine has been in operation since 1994.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider Cameco's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Cameco.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
