

Revised Notice of Public Hearing

September 8, 2011

Ref. 2011-H-02 Revision 2

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces a change in the date for Hearing Day Two on the application by Atomic Energy of Canada Limited (AECL) to renew its Nuclear Research and Test Establishment Operating Licence for the Chalk River Laboratories (CRL) located in Chalk River, Ontario. AECL has requested a five-year licence term. Hearing Day One was held on June 8, 2011 in Ottawa, Ontario.

Day Two of the public hearing will take place on October 4, 2011 only instead of October 4 and 5, 2011, as originally announced.

The renewed operating licence would allow the continued operation of the nuclear facilities at CRL, including the National Research Universal (NRU) Reactor and a number of waste management facilities. The operating licence would also allow the continued operation of radioisotope laboratories and the continued decommissioning of five shutdown nuclear facilities.
