



Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in June to consider Ontario Power Generation Inc's (OPG) application to amend the Power Reactor Operating Licence for the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station A. The reactor is located in Pickering, Ontario.

OPG is seeking acceptance from the Commission for the following administrative changes to its Pickering Nuclear Generating Station A licence: removal of the requirement for main control room panel monitoring for units 2 and 3, and the elimination of all references to the control room shift operating supervisor position.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider OPG's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and OPG.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
