The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in August to consider the proposed Project-Specific Guidelines Scoping Document for the Preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement for Cameco Corporation's (Cameco) Key Lake Extension Project. The Key Lake uranium milling operation is located in northern Saskatchewan.

Cameco is seeking acceptance from the Commission to increase the average annual production of uranium and to increase the tailings storage capacity. The Commission will consider the scope of the project and the scope of the assessment of the Key Lake Extension Project.

The hearing to consider the proposed EA Guidelines will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Cameco. There is no opportunity for the public to participate.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
