The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in August to consider the application by TRIUMF Accelerators Inc. (TRIUMF) for an amendment to the Class IB Accelerator Operating Licence for the TRIUMF site located in Vancouver, British Columbia.

TRIUMF is seeking acceptance from the Commission for an amendment to the operating licence in order to permit further site preparation work related to the ARIEL project. The preparation work involves changes to site access and egress locations and control measures, demolition of a building and excavation and shoring of the ARIEL site. This preparation work requires revisions to site drawings referenced in the operating licence. TRIUMF is requesting a licence amendment to include the revised drawings.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider TRIUMF's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and TRIUMF.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
