## Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in August to consider Dalhousie University's application for the issuance of a Licence to Abandon for its SLOWPOKE-2 Reactor (DUSR) Facility, and for the revocation of the Non-Power Reactor Decommissioning Licence for this facility. The DUSR is located in the Life Sciences Centre in the Department of Chemistry on the Dalhousie University campus in Halifax, Nova Scotia.

Dalhousie University has completed the decommissioning of the DUSR facility and is now seeking a final release from CNSC regulatory oversight of this facility through a Licence to Abandon.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider Dalhousie University's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Dalhousie University.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
