The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in August to consider NB Power's application for an amendment to the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station (NGS) operating licence. The facility is located on the Lepreau Peninsula in New Brunswick.

NB Power is seeking acceptance from the Commission for administrative changes to the Point Lepreau NGS operating licence. These changes include updates in documentation and a deletion of a licence condition that became redundant after the certification of a device owned by NB Power.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider NB Power's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and NB Power.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
