# *Revised Notice of Public Hearing*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) **announces a new deadline** for the public to file a submission for Hearing Day Two on the application by New Brunswick Power Nuclear Corporation (NBPN) to renew its Power Reactor Operating Licence for the Point Lepreau Generating Station located on the Lepreau Peninsula in New Brunswick. NBPN has requested a five-year licence term. NBPN also requested the authorization to load fuel in the reactor, according to their current licence.

Day One of the hearing was held on October 6, 2011 in Ottawa, Ontario. **The deadline for the public to file a submission for Hearing Day Two has been modified, from November 3, 2011 to November 7, 2011.**

The current licence authorizes NBPN to operate the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station and the Point Lepreau Solid Radioactive Waste Management Facility, to possess and handle certain nuclear substances and to carry out other activities described in the licence.

The public hearing will be webcasted live on the Internet via the CNSC Web site and archived for a period of 90 days.

The public is invited to comment on NBPN's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by **November 7, 2011** directly on-line (<http://www.nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/commission/intervention/index.cfm>) or at the coordinates below. The request must include the following information, as per the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation; and
- name, address and telephone of the requester.

Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. Please submit your personal information on a separate page if you wish

to ensure its confidentiality. It should be noted that all submissions are available to the public upon request to the Secretariat.

NBPN's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations considered at Hearing Day One are available upon request through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.
