

Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in November to consider Ontario Power Generation Inc's (OPG) application to amend the Nuclear Power Reactor Operating licences for the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station (NGS), the Pickering NGS-A and the Pickering NGS-B. The reactors are respectively located in Clarington and Pickering, Ontario.

OPG is seeking acceptance from the Commission for the following administrative changes: updates to revisions of documents and a revision to a Darlington NGS licence condition to reference a Canadian Standards Association (CSA) standard.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider OPG's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and OPG.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
