

Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in November to consider TRIUMF Accelerators Inc.'s (TRIUMF) request for an amendment to its operating licence for the TRIUMF particle accelerator facility located on the campus of the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, British Columbia.

TRIUMF has requested an authorization from the Commission to increase the operating limits for the irradiation of actinide targets at its ISAC (Isotope Separator and Accelerator) Facility. This authorization is requested to allow ongoing research utilizing rare isotope beams.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider TRIUMF's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and TRIUMF.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
