## ERRATUM

Cameco Fuel Manufacturing Inc.

Application for the Renewal of the Operating Licence for Cameco Fuel Manufacturing Inc. in Port Hope, Ontario

Following a hearing on November 3, 2011 and January 18-19, 2012, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC), pursuant to section 24 of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act*<sup>1</sup>, decided to renew Cameco Corporation's Nuclear Fuel Facility Operating Licence for its Fuel Manufacturing Facility located in Port Hope, Ontario. The renewed licence, FFOL-3641.00/2022, is valid from March 1st, 2012 to February 28th, 2022.

The following correction is made to the English version of the *Record of Proceedings, Including Reasons for Decision* document issued April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012 by the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission, pertaining to the Application for the Renewal of the Operating Licence for Cameco Fuel Manufacturing Inc. in Port Hope, Ontario:

On page 2 of the document, paragraph 8, the sentence

“CNSC staff shall include in the LCH the requirement for Cameco to request approval from CNSC staff before possessing enriched uranium in a quantity above 0.8 standard critical mass.”

is changed to

“CNSC staff shall include in the LCH the requirement for Cameco to request approval from CNSC staff before possessing enriched uranium in a quantity above 0.8 **smallest** critical mass (SCM).”
