The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in January to consider TRIUMF Accelerators Inc.'s (TAI) application to renew, for a three-month period, the operating licence for the TRIUMF particle accelerator facility, located on the campus of the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, British Columbia.

TAI is seeking acceptance from the Commission for a three-month renewal of its operating licence, under the same conditions as the current licence, to allow CNSC staff sufficient time to review and evaluate their application to renew their operating licence for a ten-year period.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider TAI's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from TAI and CNSC staff.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
