# Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in February to consider the University of Toronto's application to revoke the Non-power Reactor Abandonment Licence issued for their SLOWPOKE-2 Reactor Facility. The facility is located on the St. George Campus in Toronto, Ontario.

The University of Toronto is seeking acceptance from the Commission for the revocation of their Abandonment Licence to release the decommissioned facility from regulatory oversight. The decommissioning of the facility was completed in February 2001.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider the University of Toronto's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from the University of Toronto and CNSC staff.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
