The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in February to consider Nordion (Canada) Inc.'s (Nordion) application to amend the Nuclear Substance Processing Facility Operating Licence. Nordion is located in Ottawa, Ontario.

Nordion is seeking acceptance from the Commission for changes to the licence to update documentation, update the existing wording of a licence condition for clarity purposes and to modify the reporting requirement for transfers of sealed sources.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider Nordion's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from Nordion and CNSC staff.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
