The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in April to consider Ontario Power Generation Inc (OPG)'s application to amend the Nuclear Power Reactor Operating licences for the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station, Pickering Nuclear Generating Station A (PNGS-A) and the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station B (PNGS-B). The reactors are respectively located in Clarington and Pickering, Ontario.

OPG is seeking acceptance from the Commission for administrative changes to the three licences to update the revisions of documents, including the Minimum Shift Complement, Operating Policies and Principles and the PNGS-B and Darlington Site Security Reports.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider OPG's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from OPG and CNSC staff.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
