# Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a one-day public hearing to consider Canadian Light Source Inc.'s (CLSI) application to renew its particle accelerator operating licence. The facility is located in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, on the University of Saskatchewan campus. CLSI requested a renewal of the licence for a ten-year term.

The Canadian Light Source facility produces synchrotron radiation used for experiments in diverse scientific fields.

Place: CNSC Public Hearing Room, 14th floor, 280 Slater Street, Ottawa, Ontario  
Time: as set by the agenda published prior to the hearing date

The public hearing will be webcasted live on the Internet via the CNSC Web site and archived for a period of 90 days.

The public is invited to comment on CLSI's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by April 2, 2012 directly on-line at <http://www.nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/commission/intervention/index.cfm> or at the address below. Pursuant to the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, **the request must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation; and
- name, address and telephone number of the requester.

Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. Please submit your personal information on a separate page if you wish to ensure its confidentiality. It should be noted that all submissions are available to the public upon request to the Secretariat.

CLSI's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations to be considered at the hearing will be available after March 2, 2012. These documents are not downloadable. To obtain them, a request must be made to the Secretariat at the address below or directly from the Web site.
