

Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a one-day public hearing to consider the application by TRIUMF Accelerators Inc. for the renewal of the operating licence for the TRIUMF particle accelerator facilities. The facilities are located on the University of British Columbia campus, in Vancouver, British Columbia.

TRIUMF Accelerators Inc. has requested the renewal of its licence for a 10-year period, until March 31, 2022.

Time: as set by the agenda published prior to the hearing date

The public hearing will be webcasted live on the Internet via the CNSC Web site and archived for a period of 90 days.

The public is invited to comment on TRIUMF Accelerators Inc.'s application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by April 2, 2012 directly on-line at http://www.nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/commission/intervention/index.cfm or at the coordinates below. Pursuant to the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, **the request must include the following information**:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission;
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation; and
- name, address and telephone number of the requester.

Personal information, such as address and telephone numbers, is essential for linking the submission to its author. Please submit your personal information on a separate page if you wish to ensure its confidentiality. It should be noted that all submissions are available to the public upon request to the Secretariat.

TRIUMF Accelerators Inc.'s submission and CNSC staff's recommendations to be considered at the hearing will be available after March 2, 2012. These documents are not downloadable. To obtain them, a request must be made to the Secretariat at the address below or directly from the Web site.
