The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in May to consider CNSC staff's proposed Comprehensive Study Report for Cameco's planned redevelopment of its Port Hope Conversion Facility (PHCF), the Vision 2010 project. The PHCF is located in Port Hope, Ontario.

The proposed project includes:

- the cleanup and demolition of a number of old or underutilized buildings;
- the removal of contaminated soils, building materials and historic wastes at the PHCF; and
- additions or modifications to existing buildings with associated landscaping and infrastructure.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider Cameco's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Cameco.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
