The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in June to consider a request by Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) to make a correction to the recently amended Pickering Nuclear Generating Station A (NGS-A) Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence (PROL). The Pickering NGS-A is located at Pickering, Ontario.

OPG is seeking for the Commission to amend its Pickering NGS-A PROL due to an administrative error. The request is to make a correction to Appendix A.1 to properly reflect the Minimum Shift Complement table regarding a specific qualification for the Pickering NGS-B Fuel Handling staff as it is in the OPG document “P-INS-09100-00003-R006”.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider OPG’s request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and OPG.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
