Following a public meeting of the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission held on June 21, 2012 in Ottawa, Ontario, the Commission has directed CNSC staff to apply, as a matter of principle, the IAEA document TS-R-1 *Regulations for the Safe Transport of Radioactive Material*, 2009 edition, to the extent that doing so does not create conflicts with the current *Packaging and Transport of Nuclear Substances Regulations*.

This decision takes effect immediately and will remain in effect until such time as the *Packaging* and *Transport of Nuclear Substances Regulations* are amended.

The minutes for the June 21, 2012 meeting will include more detail on the above item, and will be tabled for the approval of the Commission at the next scheduled meeting of the Commission on August 15, 2012.
