Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in July to consider McMaster University's application to amend the Non-Power Reactor Operating Licence for the McMaster Nuclear Reactor (MNR). The MNR is located in Hamilton, Ontario.

McMaster University is requesting an amendment to the MNR's operating licence to reflect a change in the Class III power supply at the MNR. This change affects the description of the electrical system in MNR's Safety Analysis Report (SAR), therefore the SAR needs to be updated. A licence amendment is required to reflect the updated SAR, this document being listed in Appendix A of the MNR operating licence.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider McMaster University's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and McMaster University.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
