



Revised Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) is announcing a change to the public hearing dates regarding the application by Ontario Power Generation (OPG) to consider three matters related to OPG's Darlington nuclear site, located on the north shore of Lake Ontario in the Municipality of Clarington:

- Environmental Assessment of OPG's proposed Refurbishment and Continued Operation of the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station (DNFS);
- Application by OPG to renew the Darlington Waste Management Facility (DWMF) licence; and,
- Application by OPG to renew the Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence for the DNFS until December 31, 2014.

The public hearing will now take place on December 3 to 6, 2012 instead of November 13 and 14, 2012, as originally announced, in light of the high number of interventions.

The public hearing will be webcasted live on the Internet via the CNSC Web site and archived for a period of 90 days.

Requests to intervene previously filed with the Secretary of the Commission by the October 15, 2012 deadline will be considered at the December proceedings. No new interventions will be accepted.
