## Notice of Hearing

December 19, 2012

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in December to consider NB Power's application for amendments to the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station (NGS) operating licence. The Point Lepreau NGS is located on the Lepreau Peninsula in New Brunswick.

NB Power requested the inclusion of revised Derived Release Limits listed in Appendix A of the Point Lepreau NGS operating licence, and for an update to the current inventory of nuclear substances and prescribed equipment listed in Appendix B of the licence.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider NB Power's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and NB Power.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
