## Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in December to consider OPG's application for amendments to the Pickering nuclear generating station (NGS) A and B operating licences. The Pickering nuclear facility is located in Pickering, Ontario.

OPG requested licence amendments to incorporate the revised derived release limits for air, water and sewage and the revised minimum shift complement. CNSC staff also requested administrative corrections to the Pickering A licence.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider OPG's request in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and OPG.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
