

Revised Notice of Public Hearing

March 7, 2013 Ref. 2013-H-02 Revision 1

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) is announcing a change to the public hearing date to consider Cameco Corporation's (Cameco) application to renew, for a period of 10 years, its Waste Facility Operating Licence for the decommissioned Beaverlodge mine site, located in northern Saskatchewan.

The public hearing will now take place on April 3 and 4, 2013, instead of April 4, 2013, as originally announced.

Time: as set by the agenda published prior to the hearing date

The public hearing will be webcast live on the CNSC Web site and posted for a period of 90 days.

Requests to intervene filed with the Secretary of the Commission by March 4, 2013 will be considered at the April proceedings. No new interventions will be accepted.
