

Revised Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) is announcing a change in the start date of the public hearing regarding the application by Cameco Corporation (Cameco) to renew its uranium mine and mill operating licences for the Key Lake, McArthur River and Rabbit Lake operations located in northern Saskatchewan.

The public hearing will now begin on October 1, 2013 in the evening instead of the morning of October 2, 2013 as originally announced, to accommodate the high number of interventions.
