The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in late December 2013 to consider an extension of Shield Source Inc.'s (SSI) Nuclear Substance Processing Facility Operating Licence for its facility located in Peterborough, Ontario.

SSI discontinued the manufacture of gaseous tritium light sources in 2013. All bulk tritium and sealed tritium light sources have been shipped to licensed facilities or are packaged for shipment. Clean-up activities are almost complete. A short extension of the licence is necessary to complete all planned clean-up and reporting activities, in addition to allowing CNSC staff to complete its review of the clean-up activities.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider SSI's short-term licence renewal. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and SSI.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
