The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in January 2014 to consider the request from Bruce Power Inc. (Bruce Power) for amendments to its Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licences for the Bruce Nuclear Generating Stations A and B located in the Municipality of Kincardine, Ontario.

The proposed amendments include adding CNSC Regulatory Document RD/GD-99.3 “Public Information and Disclosure” to the Bruce A and B operating licences, and updating the operating licences with Bruce Power’s revised environmental derived release limits (DRLs).

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider this request from Bruce Power. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Bruce Power.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
