



Revised Notice of Public Hearing

April 8, 2014

Ref. 2014-H-05 – Revision 1

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public hearing to consider Cameco Corporation's (Cameco) application for a 10-year licence for its Millennium Mine Project.

Cameco is requesting a licence to mine an underground uranium deposit located approximately 600 km north of Saskatoon, within the Moon Lake drainage area, 36 km north of Cameco's Key Lake operation. The ore from this mine would be shipped to a regional mill for processing, so that no tailings would be produced or stored onsite. An environmental assessment (EA) was required under the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act (2012)*. The Commission must make a decision on the proposed EA Report before rendering its licensing decision.

The public hearing will be webcast live and then archived for a period of 90 days on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca.

Members of the public with an interest or expertise in this matter, or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision, are invited to comment on Cameco's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission by May 16, 2014, online at nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/the-commission/intervention/index.cfm or through the coordinates below.

Pursuant to the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, **the request must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by written submission only or by written submission and oral presentation
- name, address and telephone number of the requester

You may submit your personal information on a separate page if you wish to ensure its confidentiality. It should be noted that all submissions are available to the public upon request to the Secretariat.

Cameco's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations, including the proposed EA Report, will be available after April 17, 2014. These documents are not downloadable. To obtain them, a request must be made to the Secretariat at the address below or directly from the website.
