## Notice of Public Hearing and Participant Funding

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public hearing in the community in November 2014 to consider an application from Ontario Power Generation (OPG) to renew the Power Reactor Operating Licence for the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station (NGS). The Darlington NGS is located in the municipality of Clarington, on the north shore of Lake Ontario.

OPG has requested a licence valid from January 1, 2015 until December 1, 2028, to cover the period required for the completion of the proposed refurbishment of all four Darlington NGS units and completion of the major activities outlined in the Integrated Implementation Plan. A revised notice of public hearing, confirming the date and location and providing information on how to participate, will be issued at a later date.

Through its Participant Funding Program (PFP), the CNSC is offering funding to assist members of the public, Aboriginal groups, and other stakeholders in reviewing OPG's application and other relevant documentation specifically related to the application.

Participant funding up to \$75,000 is being offered for the provision of new, distinctive and valuable information, through informed and topic-specific interventions. This funding must be used to prepare for and participate in the Commission's public hearing.

The deadline for submitting a completed Participant Funding Application Form to the CNSC is **April 28, 2014.**
