



Revised Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces the postponement of the public hearing scheduled for November 2014 to consider the application from Ontario Power Generation (OPG) to renew the Power Reactor Operating Licence (PROL) for the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station (NGS). The Darlington NGS is located in the municipality of Clarington, on the north shore of Lake Ontario.

During a [hearing](#) held on July 23, 2014, the Commission approved OPG's request for a 12-month extension of its licence to allow additional time to provide more comprehensive documentation, reflect new CNSC expectations and facilitate public engagement in the upcoming public hearing.

The public hearing to consider OPG's application to renew the PROL for the Darlington NGS will take place in the summer and fall of 2015. During this hearing, the Commission will consider OPG's request for a licence to cover the period required for completing the proposed refurbishment of all four Darlington NGS units, and the completion of the major activities outlined in its [Integrated Implementation Plan](#). A new *Notice of Public Hearing* will be issued, and the public will be invited to participate.
