



Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in June 2015 to consider Hydro-Québec's application for amendments to its nuclear power reactor operating licence for the Gentilly-2 Nuclear Generating Station in Bécancour, Quebec.

Hydro-Québec is asking the CNSC to amend its operating licence to replace the reference to a regulatory document that details the information that nuclear power plant (NPP) licensees must report to the CNSC. Hydro-Québec is also asking for a reduction in the reporting requirements set out in this new document, given the facility's current state. The requested amendments are administrative in nature and will have no impact on the physical activities or work at the licensed facility.

The Commission decided that a public hearing is not necessary to consider Hydro-Québec's application. The amendments requested are administrative in nature and do not raise any issues related to health, safety or environmental protection that would warrant being considered in the context of a public hearing. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions from CNSC staff and Hydro-Québec.

Following the Commission's deliberations and decision on this matter, a record of proceedings, including reasons for decision, will be published on the CNSC website and made available to the public.
