

Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public hearing to consider an application from the Saskatchewan Research Council (SRC) to remove the hold point for Phase 2 of the Gunnar Remediation Project. The Gunnar site, located in northern Saskatchewan, is being remediated by the SRC under a CNSC waste nuclear substance licence. The licence includes a regulatory hold point that requires SRC to receive approval from the Commission before proceeding with Phase 2 of the project.

After a hearing held in September 2015, the Commission removed the hold point pertaining to the remediation of the tailings deposits at the Gunnar site. The SRC has applied to the CNSC for removal of the remainder of the hold point pertaining to the remediation of other site components, which include the waste rock piles, the open pit, the mine openings and other demolition waste.

The public hearing will be webcast live and archived for 90 days on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca.

Members of the public who have an interest or expertise in this matter, or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision, are invited to comment in writing on SRC's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by August 22, 2016 using the online request form or following the coordinates below. Pursuant to the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure, the request to intervene must include the following information:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- the requester's name, address and telephone number

All submissions are available to the public on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

SRC's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations to be considered at the hearing will be available after July 22, 2016.
