Mississauga Metals and Alloys Inc. (MMA) and David Sharpe shall, with respect to the nuclear substances stored in 71 Middleton Street:

- ensure that any trailers containing nuclear substances are not moved, relocated, or transferred to any other location.
- ensure that no person takes any action to move, relocate or transfer any trailer containing nuclear substances.

This order will remain in effect until written notification is received from the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission or the nuclear substances have been removed from the site in accordance with a plan approved by the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission.

6 Information on which order is based

MMA previously held CNSC Licence WNSL-W2-3750.00/2022 to possess, transfer, store, and manage nuclear substances on site. WNSL-W2-3750.00/2022 expired on February 28, 2022 and MMA has not submitted an application for renewal of the CNSC licence. CNSC Inspectors conducted a site visit on April 25, 2023 to April 26, 2023 to verify the status of the nuclear substances stored on the site. During this site visit, David Sharpe queried CNSC staff on the possibility of relocating the trailers containing nuclear substances on the site.

Since the nuclear substances are currently unlicensed, any attempts to move the nuclear substances would be in contravention of section 26 of the Nuclear Safety and Control Act and would demonstrate inadequate provision for the protection of the environment, and the health and safety of persons.



ORDERS OF AN INSPECTOR

35(1) Refer to this subsection for orders issued to licensees.

35(2) Refer to this subsection for orders issued to any person.

DESIGNATED OFFICERS

37(2)(f) The Commission may authorize a designated officer to make any order that an inspector may make under subsection 35(1) or (2).

PROCEDURES

38 Every order of an inspector and every order of a designated officer under paragraph 37(2)(f) shall be made, and every measure under paragraph 37(2)(c), (d) or (g) shall be taken, in accordance with the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*.

COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER

41 Every person named in or subject to an order of the Commission, an inspector or designated officer shall, regardless of whether or not the person has had an opportunity to make representations with respect to the order, comply with the order within the time specified in it or, if no time is specified, immediately.

OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD
